

Eye Exam Guideline

Assessment

- Complete an eye exam if child complains of pain, visual changes, drainage, redness, headaches, or foreign object.
- Has child received an injury to the eye?
- External exam
 - Redness, matter, drainage
- Internal exam
 - Redness, foreign object, scratch
- Vision (blurriness, double vision, spots or floaters)
- PERRL
- Ocular Movements

Recommendations

- Flush eye to see if removes foreign object
- If red and watering but not painful, notify parent and may send back to class
- If red, draining, and painful or irritated, notify parent and refer to medical provider.
- Any visual changes, PERRL, or Ocular Movement abnormalities refer to medical provider.
